Here are some ideas for a checklist of the items to include in an emergency kit for your pet or service animal. It is ideal to check the kit twice a year to restock and make sure food, water and medication are fresh.

ITEMS TO INCLUDE:

- 72-hour supply of food, water, bowls and can opener
- Special equipment that may be required
- Blanket/small toy
- Leash
- Pet carrier
- Litter bags
- List of pet shelters open 24 hours
- Pet profile document
 - Pets name
 - Type of animal
 - Medical records
 - Proof of current vaccination
 - Height/size/weight
 - Spayed/neutered/intact
 - Eye colour
 - Current photo of pet
 - ID tag/microchip
 - Copy of pet licence
 - Tattoos
 - Markings
 - Allergies
 - Pet warnings
